Scientology Harms Florida Communities

- 🏠 Real Estate Domination in Clearwater

Scientology owns over 200 properties in downtown Clearwater — many sitting empty. This has stalled economic development, displaced local businesses, and concentrated control in the hands of the church. A recent attempt to close a public street for church use was stopped after strong public opposition.

- 🏠 Expansion & Secrecy in Other Cities

Beyond Clearwater, Scientology has quietly acquired properties in Tampa, Miami, and Orlando. In many cases, these buildings sit unused, contributing nothing to local economies while avoiding taxes. Community members and officials often don't learn of the church's involvement until deals are finalized under shell companies.

- 🕵️♂️ Infiltration & Control

In Clearwater, Scientology once carried out "Project Normandy," aiming to infiltrate local government and media. Officials were targeted in smear campaigns and surveillance, part of broader efforts to manipulate civic power.

- 🚫 Harassment & Intimidation

Across Florida, critics and ex-members report aggressive tactics: surveillance, legal threats, and forced disconnection from loved ones. These actions isolate individuals and suppress public dissent.
